

Beginning in 2018, minimum stick specifications shall be as follows:

Measurement from throat (inches)	Minimum distance between narrowest point of head (inches)
1.25	3 (all measurements)
3.0	3 (all measurements)
5.0	3.5 to 4 on front, 3.5 on back
Widest point	6 (all measurements)
