## Athletic Booster Club Senior Scholarship Qualifications 2019 – 2020 School Year

### Grade Point Average

Minimum of a 2.5 cumulative G.P.A.\*

### Student Athletic Involvement

Applicant must have participated in one sport, two out of three years (one being the senior year). If applicant suffered a sports- related injury that caused them to not be able to participate, above criteria may be waived.

### Athletic Boosters (Parent) Involvement – Senior Year\*

A parent must attend a minimum of 2 monthly booster club meetings  
**AND** fulfill one of the choices listed below during the applicant's senior year:

- Work two (2) events outside your athlete's sport. (If your athlete plays two (2) or more sports, the parents of the athlete may work any two (2) events).
- Chair one (1) event (casino night, concessions, euchre tournament, \$10,000 raffle, etc.).
- Hold a Board Office (President, VP, Secretary, or Treasurer).

\*In the case an athlete's parent(s) cannot meet these requirements, a committee can be petitioned to waive the above (cases such as the athlete has no parents/guardian, medical conditions, etc.). It will then be up to the committee as to whether the athlete is eligible.

### Selection Process

A Booster Club committee will review applications to ensure that they all meet the requirements. Recipients will be picked by lottery at the May booster club meeting. A list of applicants will be included in the agenda for approval prior to the lottery drawing.

### Payment

Maximum of \$500.00 for four male and four female winners will be paid to the scholarship student upon receipt of a paid invoice from the school of their choice. Scholarship is for one year only. Scholarship is to be used for tuition, room and board, and/or textbooks.

Students who receive this scholarship and are also receiving athletic scholarship aid must verify with their university if they are eligible to receive the UHS Athletic Booster Club Award.

The scholarship award shall be forfeited immediately upon notice from the Dean or other authorized official of said institution for failure to continue with classes because of misconduct, scholastic deficiency, or other disqualifying cause.

\*In the case an athlete does not meet the required academic criteria, a committee can be petitioned to waive the GPA requirement. It will then be up to the committee as to whether the athlete is eligible.
